OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
NAT 8-16 5+ → DRURY promises SUPP
1 level: New suit = F1, 2 level: New suit = NF
New jump suit = nat GF, after pass color + supp
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
15-17 nat with stopper
4 th pos 11-15 BAL doesn’t promise stopper
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
1 suited: PRE 6+cards
2 suited: Micheals, 1m-2♦ majors -2NT unusual NT
Reopen: constructive
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Micheals, 2NT – ask for minor
1M – 3M = ask for stopper or big hand on minor
VS. NT (vs. Strong/Weak; Reopening;PH)
VS strong: dbl 4M-5m, 2♣ 5+/4+ majors, 2♦ 6+♥/♠, 2♥/♠ 5+/4+m
2NT minors, 3 level: PRE 6+
Reopen: dbl: t/o, 2♣: 5+/4+ majors, 2♦: nat weak,
2M: nat weak
VS.PREEMTS (Doubles; Cue-bids; Jumps; NT Bids)
Dbl = t/o, NT = nat
Jumps are natural and constructive
