

DEFENSIVE AND COMPETITIVE BIDDING
OVERCALLS (Style: Responses: 1 / 2 Level; Reopening)
Natural, can be light 7+H
Responses: New suit F1, weak jump raises
Reopening: no jump usually shows 7-13(14) HCP
T/O doubles can be light is shaped (8+)
INT OVERCALL (2nd/4th Live; Responses; Reopening)
2 nd pos. 15-18, same in 4 th pos. live (After Pass: 4 M and 5+ min.)
(or 4♦/5+♣)
Responses Stayman/Transfers
Reopening: 1NT 9-13, 2NT 17-19
JUMP OVERCALLS (Style; Responses; Unusual NT)
Natural and weak according to vulnerability. 1m - 2♦ majors
Unusual NT: two lower suits
DIRECT & JUMP CUE BIDS (Style; Response; Reopen)
Direct Cue-bid: two-suiter except 1♣ 2♣ and 1m 3♣ : natural
1M 2M: two suiter Clubs and OM; 1M 3♣ : O M and ♦
1M 3M: asks for stopper
VS. Weak NT X :13+, 2♣staym , transfer, 2SA : 5/5
Reopening : same
VS Strong NT
X = 5+m, 4/3M or strong, 2♣ both majors, 2♦ one major, 2♥/♠ 5♥ /♠, 4+m, 2NT both minors
Reopen: natural , X = both majors (4+/4+)
VS Weak2 :CB= asking for stopper or minor 2-suiter 4♣=♣+OM ; 4♦=♦+OM
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 1♣ X shows majors, 1-level natural, 1NT minors (2NT= minors 6/5) Jump weak
VS. ARTIFICIAL STRONG OPENINGS- i.e. 2♦ or 2♣ 2or 3x , naturel Dbl shows ♦/♣
