



South led the \bigcirc A and when North followed with the four he cashed the king and continued with the three, North ruffing and in due course scoring the \spadesuit A, -50.

South led the \heartsuit A, the trick being completed by the two, queen and ten. South switched to the \diamondsuit 3 and having taken dummy's ace declarer cashed the \clubsuit A pitching the \heartsuit 9. The appearance of South's king saw declarer continue with the \clubsuit Q which he ruffed high, ruff a diamond and pitch his last heart on the \clubsuit J. South could ruff, but with North holding the \spadesuit 10 the \spadesuit A was the last trick for the defence, +420 and 10 IMPs.

Knowing that if South held clubs his hand would be significantly stronger North was able compete.

West led the \lozenge Q and declarer won with the king as East pitched the \blacktriangle 5. Declarer cashed the \heartsuit K, crossed to dummy with the \lozenge A and ran the \heartsuit J. When it held he had nine tricks, two down, -300.



North's return of the ♣K was ruffed in dummy and declarer was able to ruff another club and a spade to emerge with 11 tricks, -100.



North led the ♣K and declarer ruffed in dummy, played a spade to the ace and a diamond, North discarding the ♠3. Having taken the ace, declarer continued with a heart to the ace as South pitched the

 \clubsuit 4. A heart to the queen was followed by the \diamondsuit Q and North ruffed and continued with the \clubsuit A. When declarer refused to ruff with dummy's jack North exited with a heart which left declarer with two losing spades, three down and a 5 IMP loss.

North led the $\heartsuit 2$ and when declarer played dummy's seven South won with the queen and switched to the $\clubsuit 9$, North winning with the king and cashing the $\diamondsuit A$. When the king appeared he continued with the $\clubsuit 10$ and declarer won with the ace, cashed the top spades and claimed nine tricks, +140.



North led the \lozenge A and continued with the seven. Declarer ruffed, cashed the \bigstar K and followed it with the \clubsuit 5. North took the king and when South contributed the nine he exited with the \clubsuit 6, declarer winning with the seven and playing the \bigstar A followed by the nine, claiming ten tricks, +420 and 7 IMPs.




VANDERBILT 2002 and MORE ACBL CHAMPIONSHIPS FROM THE ALMANAC OF POLISH BRIDGE

In 2002 MILNER team with the following players: Reese Milner (in TSC USA 4 LALL), Marc Jacobus, Sam Lev, John Mohan, Piotr Gawyrś and Jacek "Pepsi" Pszczoła won the Vanderbilt Trophy, a prestigious event, played each year during Spring Nationals. 79 teams participated and in the final MILNER won against NICKELL consisting of Nick Nickell, Richard Freeman, Bob Hamman (in TSC USA 4 LALL), Paul Soloway, Jeff Meckstroth (in TSC USA 3 LEVINE) and Eric Rodwell (in TSC USA 3 LEVINE).

The final started with the board which can happen once in a lifetime, and even in that case we do not necessarily analyze it deep enough to find the only chance to make the contract.

Very detailed bidding of the Poles enabled Hamman to do double $4 \spadesuit$ bid. Please, note, that after club lead declarer makes $6 \diamondsuit$ without any problems.

But Soloway led ♠2 and Pszczoła was faced with a tough problem.

The easiest solution would be to assume that double of $4 \spadesuit$ was a bluff and a simple spade finesse works. But North player was Bob Hamman and Jacek rejected this solution.

What were the other opportunities?

Pszczoła have found, that if North has void in diamonds together with doubleton in hearts, a slam can be made. After this assumption the play was easy.

Spade was won with the ace, now two top clubs and 4 rounds of hearts... Poor North had to follow hearts with black cards and watch how his spade trick disappeares...

Defenders took only the ace of trumps. 920 for East/West, and a tie, as in the replay $6 \diamondsuit$ was made after a club lead.

Could anybody calculate what were declarer's odds of finding a dream distribution and making the contract?

Finally MILNER won 199-115 (55-22, 23-29, 78-32, 43-32).
